Whether it's a 10 minute counseling call, a night of hospital advocacy, or years of support through counseling and court advocacy, GaDuGi SafeCenter is there for victims and survivors of sexual violence

In 2014, staff and volunteer advocates provided 1,385 hours of service to 335 women, men, and children.

"GaDuGi" is a Cherokee word that means to work with the community.

Ending sexual violence is impossible without community engagement. In 2013, the agency provided **106 presentations & trainings that reached 3,041 people** throughout Douglas, Franklin, and Jefferson Counties.
